On this trip we will mix the beauty of Canadian art glass with special sites in Toronto. We start off our tour with brunch hosted by Sandra Ainsley Gallery, where we will view a stunning array of art glass from the artists she represents. We will also view 6 world class private collections on this trip, and enjoy studio visits and demonstrations from a number of artists including Jeff Goodman, Susan Rankin, Donald Robertson, Irene Frolic, and Charlie Pachter.

We will also visit the exciting new Aga Kahn Museum. This architectural beauty designed by a Pritzker Prize winner is set within beautiful gardens and surrounded by a large park. It houses an incredible collection of Islamic art and heritage. Another stop is the unique Bata Shoe Museum, which collects, researches, and preserves footwear from around the world, for their exhibitions. And our trip concludes with a very special behind the scenes tour of the Royal Ontario Museum – another architectural design award winner.

On this trip we will enjoy 3 days full of art glass, touring collections, visiting artist studios, and seeing artist demonstrations, with a few notable sites mixed in. Our group will also sample local cuisine in noted Toronto restaurants, and have a chance to browse the beautiful Sandra Ainsley Gallery. Some attendees may choose to add in their own side trip to Corning on their way home, to see the new wing of the Museum!

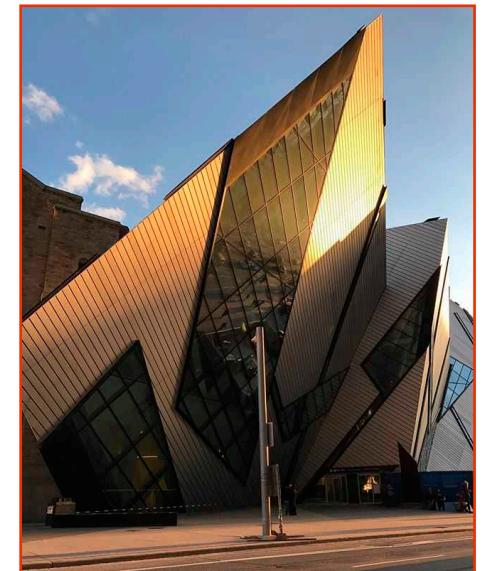
